(SAMPLE)

Silverdale Water District issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) under the State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter 197-11 WAC) for the following project: Installation of approximately 1,340 lineal feet of 16" ductile iron water main along Newberry Hill Road and 4,600 lineal feet of 12" ductile iron water main along Hillcrest Street, Central Valley Road, and Anna Road within the Central Kitsap area. The project area is within Sections 2, 3, & 30, in Township 25 North, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, Kitsap County. Water mains will be installed along the following roads: Newberry Hill Road, Hillcrest Street, Central Valley Road, and Anna Road. After review of a complete environmental checklist and other information on file with the agency, Silverdale Water District has determined this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
