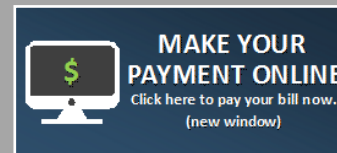

WHAT'S SILVERDALE WATER DOING..... *on Chena Road?*

In the fall of 2016, construction began on the new pump station at the site of our 2 million gallon reservoir on Chena Road. Upon completion, this



640 square foot pump station will move up to 3000 gallons-per-minute (GPM) of water along Ridgetop Boulevard through three new booster pumps—one pump moving up to 2000 GPM. That's the equivalent of 6.6 five-gallon buckets of water every second!

The building will also contain a separate room that will house a 250 gallon sodium hypochlorite tank. Additionally, a standby emergency backup generator was installed onsite in November

2016. The project is scheduled to be completed in May 2017 with an estimated cost of \$770,000.
