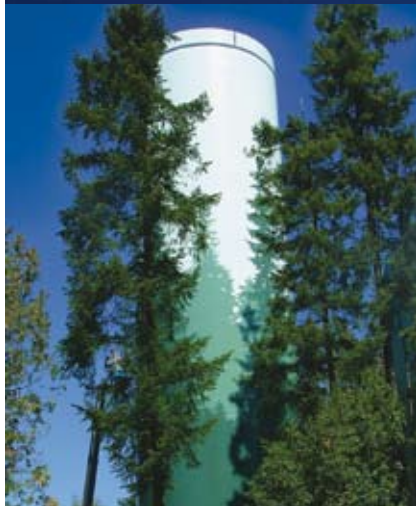




Our Mission

Island Lake

Our Island Lake Reservoir upgrade is nearing completion. This was part of our district-wide reservoir seismic upgrade. The district received a \$1.1 Million dollar grant from FEMA to equip our reservoirs with earthquake valves to control unwanted flow from the reservoirs in the event of an earthquake. This project has been in the works since the Nisqually earthquake in 2001.

Conservation Tips

Efficient water use can save you money on water & utility bills, and reduce the costs for sewer and septic services. Use the following household tips in the bathroom, kitchen and laundry room to help protect the environment and save your family money!

Check faucets, pipes, and toilets for leaks.

Reduce the water level per flush by installing a low-flow toilet or a toilet displacement device.

Don't let the bathroom sink run while wetting your toothbrush, brushing your teeth or when shaving.

Use both sides of the sink when washing dishes by hand; one side to wash and the other side to rinse. Do not wash dishes under a running faucet.

In-sink garbage disposal devices use roughly 11.5 gallons of water each day. Try composting organic wastes instead of throwing them away.

Use the proper water level, load size selection and water temperature when washing clothes.

Irrigation System Safety

Time to Winterize

Winterizing your irrigation system is simple:

1. Turn off the water to the irrigation system at the main valve.
2. Set the automatic irrigation controller to the "rain" setting.
3. Turn on the control valves to each zone to release pressure in the pipes.
4. Drain all of the water out of any irrigation components that might freeze.
