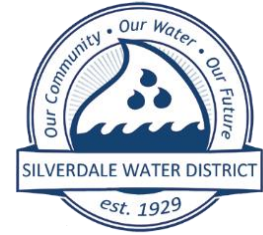


Utility Billing

NOTICE TO LEGAL OWNER: *The Revised Code of Washington (RCW) Section 57.08.081 provides that water charges are charges against the property served. Consequently, you as the owner become liable for unpaid charges if the property manager does not pay the charges. The District will bill the property manager in an attempt to collect the charges. If after sixty (60) days these charges have not been paid, the District will file a lien on the property. Failure to resolve this lien may result in termination of water service.*
